City of Calgary Open Flame Permit

Event organizers or those companies looking to use burn barrels, candles, ceremonial smouldering or any type of open flame outside of a performance with open will have to apply for the above permit and will require the following information:

- 1. Put a call into 311 requesting the specific type of permit they are applying for.
- 2. Have someone who is approved by the venue to provide a written letter of permission allowing the performance or display to take place whether it is inside or outside.
- 3. The venue must provide a fire safety plan, including how they plan to mitigate a false alarm from the effects of the flame; should the venue have a fire detection system. If a false alarm is caused by the performance, a false alarm fee will be charged.
- 4. The organizer must provide a fire safety plan, including props being used, who and how are the props being supervised the number and type of extinguishing tools and there placement.
- 5. The organizer must provide proof of insurance in the amount of \$2 million liability for open flame permits. The Calgary Fire Department (or City of Calgary) should be listed as additional insured for all permits.
- 6. Provide a site plan of the intended location including reference and/or measurements for proximity to combustibles, staff and public. For open flame props, such as burn barrel or a smudging ceremony a minimum of 1 meter must be maintained between the props and the public, at all times, with some type of physical barrier.
